PREPARATION

- All surfaces must be well prepared and free from dirt, oil, grease, mould and other contaminants.
- Previously coated timber requires complete stripping back to bare timber to allow Qcoat oil to penetrate.
- Where external timber has completely greyed in colour, the timber should be rejuvenated either
 by sanding or using a propriety timber cleaner. All moss, algae, lichen etc must be completely
 removed using chlorine bleach or a propriety mould treatment. Use according to package
 directions.
- When the timber has faded to a pale colour or water is not beading on the surface, simply reapply Qcoat to the clean, dry surface. Severely weathered surfaces need additional treatment as per above.

APPLICATION

NOTE: New timber should be coated on all 4 sides before installation.

- 1. Calculate quantity of oil required:
 - a. For pine allow 10-12m2 per liter.
 - b. For hardwood allow 6-8m2 per liter.
 - c. The 2nd coat will require less oil.
- 2. Stir the oil thoroughly before using a wide flat stirrer, ensuring the bottom of tin is reached.
- 3. Use a brush or wool applicator to evenly spread the coating onto timber wipe off excess material 1-2 hours after application.
- 4. Take time to ensure cut and exposed ends are thoroughly soaked to minimize water penetration.
- 5. Allow 6-8 hours for oil to dry before applying 2nd coat.
- 6. After the 2nd coat allow a further 24 hours before walking on.

TIP: To avoid overcoating the timber (oil becomes tacky), add mineral turpentine to the oil (up to 20% of your oil qty), this will increase timber absorption of the oil.

MAINTENANCE

NOTE: Each coat is cumulative and builds up additional stability & protection.

- Re-coating time depends on usage and weather exposure.
- If water stops beading on the surface, a recoat is required.

SAFETY

- Keep out of reach of children.
- Avoid contact with skin and eyes.
- Ensure the coating area is well ventilated.
- Wear appropriate personal protection equipment.
- Keep away from potential sources of ignition Qcoat is solvent based and flammable.

FIRST AID
